8 proposition that the sport must independently act as quickly, as relentlessly, and
9 with the most effectiveness that it can against transgressing athletes. Landis can now
10 immediately be suspended and as a result of the process will be suspended for two
11 years without his excuses hindering that process. This is exactly the policy that we
12 stand for in the IOC and in German athletics, and the policy that we want. If we
13 depended only on the legal system, months and years could go by in a formal court
14 before a doper could be removed from the sport.
